

Charge of Arson

John James Couzens, baker and postmaster, of Berwick Bassett, surrendered to his bail, before the Swindon magistrates on Saturday, on a charge of arson, the allegation being that he wilfully set fire to premises in his occupation at Bushton, on September 27th. The premises were insured for \pounds 550. Damage was done to the extent of \pounds 275. The Chairman said the Bench were unanimously of opinion that the case should go for trial. Prisoner having been cautioned, a statement was made on his behalf that he was not guilty and could account for his whereabouts on the night in question. He reserved his defence. Bail was allowed - prisoner in \pounds 50 and in two other sureties \pounds 25 each.
