Berwick Bassett or Barwick Bassett, is a township and parish in Calne Hundred, Marlborough Union, North Wilts, 9 miles north-west from Marlborough and 7 south from Wootton Bassett station, with 1,388 acres and a population, in 1851, of 205. There is a church; the curate is the Rev. ___ Penruddock. There is National school. The living is a donative, with £40 per annum, in the gift of the Vicar of Calne. The River Kennet passes near.
