Henry William aged 5 years, baptised 28th December 1837; George aged 3 years baptised 24th August 1838; Another son James was born aboard ship.

William Lanham was baptised in St. John church, Bishopstone on 24th February 1807. Anne was the daughter of Henry & Anne Case (nee Williams)
