County Petty Sessions Breach of the Peace William Musselwhite, John Compton, Henry Compton, Edward Compton and Emanuel Compton, were charged with fighting and creating a disturbance at Bishopstone. They were all bound over to keep the peace for three months, and each defendant had to pay nine shillings costs.
