APPORTIONMENT of the **RENT-CHARGE** in lieu of **TITHES** in the Parish of Blackland In the County of Wilts

Whereas an Award of rent charge in lieu of TITHES in the Parish of Blackland

County of Wilts was, on the sixteenth day of June in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty Five, confirmed by the Tithe Commissions For England and Wales, of which Award, with the Schedule therein comprised, the following is a Copy:-

Know all Men by the presents that I Aneurin Owen having been duly appointed and sworn an Assistant Tithe Commissioner according to the provisions of the Act for the Commutation of Ttthes in England and Wales and having also duly appointed to ascertain and award the sums to be paid by way of rent charges instead of the tithes of the Parish of Blackland in the County of Wilts do hereby award as follows that is to say – Whereas I have held divers meetings near to the said Parish touching the matter aforesaid of which meetings due notices were given for the information of the Land Owners and Tithe owners of the said Parish And Whereas due notice was given to me in the manner prescribed by the said Act that the clear average payments instead of the tithes of the said Parish during the seven years preceding Christmas in the year One Thousand eight hundred and thirty five would not fairly represent the sum which ought to be the basis of a permanent Commutation of the said tithes And Whereas I have duly considered all the allegations and proofs tendered to me touching the matter of the said notice and have myself made all enquires which appeared to me to be necessary before awarding the rent charges herein after mention And Whereas I find that the estimated quantity in statute measure of all the lands of the said amounts to five hundred and thirty seven acres which are cultivated or used as follows that is to say -

Two hundred and one acres as Arable Land
Two hundred and fifty acres as meadow and Pasture Land
Twenty nine acres as Down Land
Thirty two acres as wood Land
Sixteen acres as Homesteads Gardens and Orchards
Five acres are Rectorial Glebe Lands
And Four acres are roads and waste

And Whereas I find that the tithes arising and accruing from the Rectorial Glebe Lands of the said Parish have been duly declared to be merged in the said Lands and that such declaration of merger has been duly confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales

And Whereas I find that the tithes arising and accruing from certain Lands in the said Parish situate in Blackland North field containing by estimation twenty seven acres Statute measure of which William Tanner Esquire is owner and Henry Maundrell is occupier have been duly declared to be merged in the said Lands and that such declaration of merger has been duly confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales And Whereas I find that the tithes arising and accruing from certain Lands in the said Parish situate in Blackland North Field containing by estimation seventeen acres Statute measure of which William Tanner Esquire is owner and Henry Maundrell is occupier belong to the Rector of Calstone Wellington And Whereas I find that all other unmerged tithes arising and accruing within the said Parish belong to the Rector of Blackland. Now Know Ye that I the said Aneurin Owen do hereby award that the annual sum of seven pounds by way of the rent charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the Rector of Calstone Wellington for the time being instead of those tithes arising and accruing within the said Parish of Blackland to which he is entitled as hereinbefore mentioned that the annual sum of One hundred and thirty one pounds by way of rent charge subject to the provisions of the said Act shall be paid to the Rector of of Blacklands for the time being instead of all other unmerged tithes arising and accruing within the said Parish of Blackland to which he is entitled as herein before mentioned And I do hereby further award that the said rent charge shall commence from the first day of October preceding the confirmation of the Apportionment thereof – In testimony whereof I the said Aneurin Owen have hereunto set my hand this fourteenth day of June in the year of the Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty five.
