

Kellys Directory Extract 1867 Box



BOX is a parish, railway station and large village in the Northern division of the county, hundred, union and county court district of Chippenham, diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, archdeaconry of Bristol, and rural deanery of Malmesbury South, on the Great Western Railway, 5 miles north-east from Bath, 8 south-west from Chippenham and 101¾ from London. The church of St. Thomas à Becket, is an ancient structure, consisting of a nave, Chancel, and two, aisles, with spire containing 5 bells. The living is a vicarage, tithe rent-charge £408, in the gift of, and held by, the Rev. H. D. C. S. Horlock, D.D., of Magdalen Hall, Oxford. There is a chapel of ease at Kingsdown. Here there are National schools for boys and girls. The Wesleyans have a chapel here. W. B. Northey, Esq., is lord of the manor. The principal landowners are Edward R. Northey, William B. Northey, J. B. and T. H, A. Poynder, Esqrs. The Great Western Railway passes through a tunnel here, called Box Tunnel. Here are extensive stone quarries. There is some brewing and malting. The soil is various. The chief crops are wheat, barley and oats. The population in 1861 was 2,051. The parish contains 4,217 acres.

Hazlebury, Wormwood, Rudloe, Cheney Court, Wadswick, Calls, Hill Farm, Sheylors, and Shades, are places in this parish.
