

half a mile south from Codford station on the Salisbury and Westbury branch of the Great Western railway,

BOYTON is a parish, on the river Wiley, in the Southern division of the county, hundred of Heytesbury, Warminster union and county court district, diocese and archdeaconry of Salisbury and rural deanery of Wylye, 3 miles south-east from Heytesbury, 7 south-east from Warminster, and 121 from London. The church of St. Mary the Virgin, a fine specimen of Early English architecture, was restored in 1860, and consists of nave, chancel, the Lambert chapel, and north transept, with a square tower containing 4 bells. The register dates from 1560. The living is a rectory, value £549, with residence, in the patronage of Magdalen College, Oxford, and held by the Rev Richard Zouche Walker, M.A., late fellow of that college. Here is a small school, which is supported by the lord of the manor. The Rev. Prebendary Arthur Fane, B.A., is lord of the manor and principal landowner. The soil is light chalk; subsoil, chalk and flint. The chief crops are wheat, oats and barley. The parish contained 410 inhabitants in 1861, with an area is 3,956 acres; rateable value £2,683.

CORTON (or CORTINGTON) is a township, one mile north-west from the village, where there is a place of worship for Baptists.
