



Land & Buildings Broad Chalke

1849

The tithe payers of Broad Chalke, Bower Chalke, and Alvediston, have petitioned the provost and scholars of King's College, Cambridge, (the owners of the great tithes in these parishes,) for a reduction commensurate with the altered prices of agricultural produce; and also for a postponement, for two months, for the period of collecting the tithes, as they allege that it is not possible, in the present depressed state of the market, to dispose of their produce.
