



## NATIONAL EGG COLLECTION Another Two Thousand Eggs

Over 2,000 eggs were collected and sent away last week, the total being 2,147. The districts to show an increase were Keevil and Hinton, Semington, Bradley and Broker's Wood, Holt and Broughton Gifford, Wingfield and Road Common, Heywood, Beanacre, and Westwood. Melksham's return was exactly the same as the previous week. The number from Trowbridge itself is very disappointing, and the same applies to the town of Westbury.
