Mr. William Potter, of New Zealand, Calne, has dug 161 lbs. of Northern Star potatoes from 1lb. of seed which he planted in the spring. The biggest haulm weighed over 10½ lbs., and several weighed over 8lb. Wiltshire Times, 15 October 1904 OPC Note:- A haulm is the number or weight of potatoes produced from a single plant when dug.
