Mr. John Rumming (left) of Magnolia, Compton Bassett, who sent in the photo above to a local newspaper of Castle Come schoolchildren writes:-

Miss Brockway was the headmistress and drove her Morris 8 car from Chippenham each day.

The infant teacher was Miss L. Gittis who came from Castle Combe. Five members of my family – myself included – are pictured on it.

Many of the children had several miles to walk each day as no transport was available in those days. I walked from Lower Colham and others walked from places such as Long Dean and Gibb. And as Trowbridge

County records show, if the pupils were late – as indeed I was together with my brother one day, due to a heavy thunder storm – you were marked absent for that morning.

No hot meals were provided (we had to bring sandwiches but hot water was available for those who could bring cocoa, although we couldn't always afford to bring milk and sugar! Scotts Emulsion was administered daily, or was it once a week? It was so long ago but I still remember the taste – ugh!

No doubt others will recall similar memories of their school days at 'Combe when they see the photograph.
