Wednesday night, **Mr. Lewis**, a paper maker of Long Dean, near Castle Combe, Wilts was killed near Bitton, Glos. by a fall from his horse returning from our fair. His neck was dislocated and his leg broke in two places. His horse was found grazing near him next morning.
