

Post Office Directory Extract 1855

Castle Combe



Upper and Lower Castle Combe is a township, parish and village, 6 miles north-west of Chippenham, 6 miles east-bynorth-east of Marshfield, 11 miles north of Bath, and 100 from London, in the Hundred and Union of Chippenham, North Wilts. The living is a rectory, value £883, in the gift of George Powlett Scrope, Esq.; the Rev. Richard Cooper Christie, M.A., is the incumbent. The church is an ancient structure, with tower, containing 2 bells, in good repair, and in the Gothic style. Here are two chapels - viz., Independent and Baptist; and a National school for boys and girls. The population, in 1851, was 557. The parish contains 1,494 acres, and 128 houses. William Scrope, Esq., is lord of the manor. On the hill is a camp.

Ford, Bybrook, Shrub, and Colham, are other places in the township.
