

Bankruptcy of John Edward Carter

Re: John Edward Carter. - In the matter of liquidation proceedings of John Edward Carter, late of Castle Eaton rectory, Wiltshire, and now of No 1 Brunswick Place, Bath, clerk in holy orders, Mr Poole made a motion that the interim order made on the 2nd of January last restraining Mr Samuel Barfield from removing or selling household furniture and effects under an assignment, dated 1st Feb 1868 (made by the debtor of one Loftus Henry Martin) might be discharged. - Mr Macpherson, on behalf of the trustees opposed the motion. - The Rev J E Carter was examined, and counsel having been heard on each side, his Honour reserved judgment.
