1813

Married – Mr John Godfrey of Ashton Keynes to Miss Beard of Castle Eaton, Wilts. Cheltenham Chronicle Thursday 23 December 1813

1814

On Tuesday the 11th instant died, at Marlborough, Mrs Kerby, relict of the Rev L Kerby, late Rector of Castle Eaton, in this county. Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 24 October 1814

1815

On Tuesday was married, at Marlborough by the Rev Cranley Kerby, William Francis Norton, Esq of Somerton, to Marianne youngest daughter of the Rev L Kerby, late Rector of Castle Eaton, Wilts, and sister to the late P Kerby, Esq of this city.

Hampshire Chronicle Monday 3 August 1815

1817

On Thursday se'nnight was married at Somerton, Capt Perry RN to Martha, daughter of the late Rev Lancelot Kerby, Rector of Castle Eaton, Wilts. Hampshire Chronicle Monday 3 November 1817

1828

Married, Rev T Bullock of Castle Eaton, to Ellenor, third daughter of T Morris of Marlborough. Bath Chronicle and Weekly Gazette Thursday 10 July 1828

Married on the 3rd inst, at Marlborough, the Rev T Bullock of Castle Eaton, Wilts, to Ellen, second daughter of Dr Morris Hampshire Chronicle Monday 14 July 1828

1829

Died on Tuesday the 17th inst at Longbridge Deverill, Wilts, the Rev Henry Goddard, Vicar of that parish, and Rector of Castle Eaton, in the same county. Hampshire Chronicle Monday 23 March 1829

1835

Married at Castle Eaton, near Highworth, Mr John Herbert, fisherman, aged 87 to Sarah Cook aged 67. Salisbury and Winchester Journal Monday 5 January 1835

1836

Died Nov 17, John Thelwall, infant son of the Rev T Maurice, of Castle Eaton, Wilts. **Bristol Mercury Saturday 26 November 1836**

1841

On the 26th instant at Castle Eaton in this county, by the Rev W B Bradford, Elizabeth eldest daughter of Mr Poulton of Lushill, to Mr Chamberlen of South Leaze, near Swindon. Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 28 October 1841

1842

Died at Castle Eaton on Monday se'nnight, Mr Archer gent, aged 90 years – Also in the adjoining parish of Hannington, Mr Stephen Dixon aged 92; and Mr Joseph Jarvis, aged 88. - viz., three neighbours died within 36 hours whose united ages amount to 270 years.

1843

Married on Thursday the 28th inst at West Knoyle by the Rev J S Stockwell Rector of Whylye, Mr James Chisman of Castle Eaton, in this county, to Anne eldest daughter of Mr W W Rumsey of the former place. Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 30 December 1843

1845

On the 1st instant at Hatfield, Herts, the Rev William Barhurst Bradford of Castle Eaton, in this county, to Mary Elizabeth, only child of the late Rev Charles Woodcock Keysali.

Died on the 21st inst at Warminster, aged 74, Mary widow of the Rev Henry Goddard, Vicar of Longbridge Deverell and Castle Eaton in this county. Salisbury and Winchester Journal Saturday 25 October 1845

1846

On the 12th instant at the Rectory, Castle Eaton, the lady of the Rev William B Bradford, of a still born child. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette Thursday 23 April 1846**

Died on Oct 29, the Rev Thomas Bullock, Rector of Castle Eaton, and Vicar of Chisledon, in the county of Wilts, aged 46. **Berkshire Chronicle Saturday 7 November 1846**

1847

On the 9th inst at Avington Church, Berks, by the Rev Mr Gordon, Mr Jeffs of Hungerford to Ann, second daughter of the late John Green Esq of Castle Eaton, Wilts. Reading Mercury Saturday 12 June 1847
