#### 1917

Died Aug 31, 1917, suddenly at 221 Newfoundland Road, Alfred the beloved son of the late William Bridges and grandson of the late Richard Bridges, Castle Eaton, Wilts, and of the late William Giller, Old Post Office Road Tavern, Broad Street (City) aged 70. ## 1918

Died on the 12th October at Eastnor Lodge, Reigate, Edgar last survivor of the children of the late Rev John Sharpe formerly Rector of castle Eaton, Wilts, in the hundred and second year of his age.
