

The Converted Glebe Barn, Castle Eaton

Castle Eaton Glebe Lands

On Monday last, Mr James Villar let by auction, at the King's Head Hotel, about 80 acres of land, forming part of the glebe, the property of the Rev C Bowlby, for a period of seven years from Michaelmas, 1867.

Lot 1 of about 50 acres realised £135; lot 2, 21a 2r 3p - £35; lot 3, the first math or crop, and common rights for six beasts, in Thames meadow from August to February, 6a 3r 11p - £36. Total £206 per annum. The purchaser was Mr Charles Lock, of Cirencester.
