On Friday the freehold estate at Castle Eaton, Wiltshire, on the borders of Gloucestershire, consisting of a dwelling house, stables, and other buildings, and 557 acres of land, with 21 cottages and tenements, the whole forming the principal part of Castle Eaton, was knocked down at the Mart for £25,300.
