

Freeman Sisters Died the Same Day

On Wednesday morning last, died at Appleshaw, aged 58, Mrs. Charlotte Roquemont, relict of Henry, Baron de Roquemont and Chevalier of the Order of St Louis, youngest daughter of the late John Freeman, Esq, of Chute Lodge. In this lady were united all the mild and amiable qualities which reflect peculiar lustre on the female character; meek, humane and charitable, her utmost endeavours were uniformly exerted to promote the happiness of others. She was an honorary member of the Friendly Society held at Appleshaw; and she sat at her window, though in a very weak state, supported by a medical attendant, wearing the colours of the society, to view their procession as they passed to and from church on Whit Tuesday last.

On the same evening of the same day, died, sincerely lamented, Emily, wife of Lieutenant Colonel Duke, of Appleshaw, sister of the lady above mentioned, and third daughter of the late John Freeman Esq of Chute Lodge, in this county.
