Newspaper Reports

John Ingram 21st May, 1827

Mr Whitmarsh held an inquest on Monday last, at Compton Chamberlayne, on the body of John Ingram, who had hung himself in his own kitchen, about four o'clock that morning. The deceased had been in a desponding state for a number of years, frequently saying that he must destroy himself.

Verdict, "Hung himself in a fit of insanity."
