

SOUTH WILTSHIRE CORONER'S INQUESTS

Albert Noyce 8th May, 1908 4 Year Old Knocked Down By a Car

The Coroner for South Wilts, Mr R. A. Wilson, held an inquest at the Manor Farm, Compton Chamberlayne, yesterday (Thursday), on the body of a little boy named Albert Charles Noyce, aged four years and eleven months, who on Tuesday evening ran in front of a motor car, was knocked down and killed.

The evidence given showed that the driver, Mr W. Lowther, jnr, of Salisbury, sounded his horn several times, and the jury, in giving a verdict of "Accidental death," exonerated him from all blame.
