

# Kelly's Directory Extract 1867 Compton Chamberlayne



**Compton Chamberlayne** is a parish and village, in the Southern division of the county, South Damerham hundred, Wilton Union, Salisbury county court district, diocese and archdeaconry of Salisbury and rural deanery of Chalke, 6 miles west-by-south from Wilton, 9 from Salisbury and 94 from London by South Western Railway.

The church of St Michael is a small ancient cruciform structure, with square tower and 3 bells; the interior contains a tablet to the memory of the Penruddocke family, who have been interred here since 1598, one of whom, Col. John Penruddocke, was beheaded by Cromwell's orders.

The register dates from 1538. The living is a vicarage in the gift of Charles Penruddocke, esq., and held by the Rev. Arthur Whitmarsh Phelps, M.A., of Worcestor College, Oxford.

Compton Park is the seat of Charles Penruddocke, esq., D.L., J.P., who is lord of the manor and owns the entire parish, with the exception of a small portion belonging to the priory of St John.

The soil is clay, chalk, and green sand; subsoil, the same. The chief crops are wheat, barley and roots. The area is 2,130 acres, and the population in 1861 was 348.
