- Benefactions to  
Certain Poor of This Parish
- FIRST                    † The sum of Five Pounds charged upon an Estate at Farley in this County left by John Hancocke and now in the possession of the Earl of Radnor to be given away by the Minister unto the Poorest inhabitant's on the Feast of St. John the Evangelist for ever
- SECOND                † The interest of the sum of forty five Pounds to be distributed in Bread on Christmas Eve by the Minister & Churchwardens
- THIRD                   † The sum of Fifty Pounds left by Mr. David Feltham upon trust to the Poor of the Parish of Coombe Bissett the Interest of which to be applied in the purchase of Bread to be distributed by the Vicar and Churchwardens of the aforesaid Parish in such manner as they shall think proper on the 1st Day of December for ever
- FOURTH                † The sum of One hundred Pounds left by Miss Elizabeth and Miss Margaret Fleetwood on Trust to the aged Poor of the Parish of Coombe Bissett the Interest of which to be applied in the purchase of Coal to be distributed by the Vicar and Churchwardens at their discretion
