Woman charged with stealing four handkerchiefs Hindon Petty Sessions, Wednesday. Before R. Graves, Esq. (Chairman), Lord Arundell, Troyte Bullock, and V. F. Benett-Stanford, Esqs. Louisa Haskell, of Donhead St Andrew, was charged with stealing four pocket handkerchiefs and a large number of other articles, the property of Mr Jno. Bennett. Committed to prison for one month, and three years to a reformatory. Western Gazette 23 February 1872
