

CORONERS INQUESTS



Donhead St. Andrew 1800-1899

On the 8th inst., an inquest was held by R. M. Wilson, Esq., on the body of a child aged one year and ten months, named Edward Joseph Adams, who was found drowned in a pond near the house, on the 6th inst., the mother and father being from home at the time of the child's death. Dr. Thompson, of Rombery, stated there was not the slightest appearance of any external injury. The jury returned their verdict of "Accidentally drowned." Western Gazette, 14 June 1867
