Summary of Objects

To give practical form to the comradeships which grew and developed in the Burma Campaign.

Membership is restricted to men and women who are entitled to wear the Burma Star, or the "Burma" clasp to the Pacific Star.

Associate Membership is restricted to those who served in S. E. Asia but did **not** earn the Burma Star. They have the same privileges as Burma Star members except that they are not entitled to vote at Meetings concerned with the conduct of Association affairs. Application for Associate Membership presumes acceptance of this restriction.

Members are entitled to a seat at the annual re-union at a cheaper rate than is charged to nonmembers. The rates to be charged will be decided by the Council each year.
