East Knoyle 1800-1849

1830

Mr. Whitmarsh held an inquest on Thursday last, at East Knoyle, on the body of Thomas Maidment. The deceased was at work in a chalk-pit the previous Tuesday, when the soil above fell down and suffocated him. Verdict, "Accidental death." Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 29 April 1830

1836

Mr. Whitmarsh held an inquest, on the 8th inst., at East Knoyle, on the body of Hannah Perman, who was taken ill on the previous Monday morning, and died on the following day, without having received medical assistance. Verdict, "Natural death." Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 18 April 1836
