POSITION OF MEMBERS SERVING IN THE NAVY, ARMY OR AIR FORCE

The Central Committee recently re-considered the position of members of the Men's Society serving in the Navy, Army or Air Force. They have decided that such members, if they so desire, may re-commence payment of contributions as from the 1st January, 1946. The payment of contributions by any members still serving in the Navy, Army or Air Force is, of course, not compulsory during the period of the emergency, and any members who do not resume payment will not be liable to forfeiture of membership, and will not, in consequence of such non-payment during service, be considered in arrears under Section 6. of Rule VI. (Payment at death of a member), or Section 8. of Rule VI. (Allowance towards funeral expenses at death of a member's wife). Any members resuming payment contributions as from 1st January, 1946, and who are still serving in the Navy, Army or Air Force, will not, in consequence of non-payment of contributions during service between 1st September, 1939 and the 1st January, 1946, be considered in arrears under Section 17. Of Rule V. or Section 6 and 8 of Rule VI. Members who may be discharged from any of the Services must give immediate notification to their Lodge Secretary, and state the effective date of discharge. Payment of contributions must be resumed from the first Lodge night following the effective date of discharge, otherwise arrears will accrue from that date.
