Wilts Epiphany Sessions Thomas Beckley, charged with having stolen two sacks and one bushel of wheat, the property of Robert Green at Fugglestone St. Peter. Guilty, 6 months imprisonment. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**

Wilts Epiphany Sessions Fanny Read, charged with having endeavoured to rescue one Henry Jones, charged with robbery, then in the custody of the said John Bunter, and with having assaulted him in the execution of his duty, as Police Constable, at Fugglestone Saint Peter. Guilty: 4 months imprisonment. **Wiltshire Independent, 12 January 1843**
