

## William Talbot - His Criminal Career

Six Weeks: William Talbot (in solitude), for stealing lead at Fugglestone St. Peter:

Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 16 January 1837

Transportation: Seven years: William Talbot, stealing cheeses at Fugglestone St. Peter (Thomas Talbot, 4 month's imprisonment, and twice whipped)

Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 26 October 1837

## **Tasmanian Records show:**

William Talbot, age 20, labourer, was transported to Van Diemen's Land on the Gilmore, arriving 24 January 1839.

Single, previous offences - stealing boots - 14 days; stealing lead - 6 weeks; stealing turnips - 1 week

Free Certificated dated 20 August 1852.

Expiration of sentence reported in the Cornwall Chronicle, (Tasmania), Saturday, 28 August 1852.
