Abraham Whiting, of Great Cheverall, was charged by Mr. Superintendent Wolfe with a similar offence, (selling bread without weights and scales) on the 27th of Sept last. Mr. Wolfe said that defendant's man, Hawkins, was selling the bread. He weighed several loaves, and they were all good weight.
