Approval of Proposed Exchange of Land

ATHEREAS the RIGHT HONORABLE CHARLES JOHN EARL of SUFFOLK and BERKSHIRE, of Charlton Park, in the county of Wilts, and JOHN MILLS WHITE, of Cherington, in the county of Gloucester, gentleman, being respectively interested under the provisions of "The Acts for the Inclosure, Exchange, and Improvement of Lands," in the Land and Hereditaments set forth in the Schedule hercunder written, with the Easements and Appurtenances thereunto belonging, and being desirous of EFFECTING an EXCHANGE of the same, have made application, in writing, to the Inclosure Commissioners for England and Wales, to direct enquiries whether such proposed Exchange would be beneficial to the Owners of such respective Lands and Hereditaments, and to proceed with the same under the provisions of the said Acts.
