**1859**

Marriage March 17th, at the Independent Chapel, Highworth, by the Rev. Thomas Gilbert, Mr. Robert Fox, builder, of Bishopstone, to Ann, daughter of Mr. Gibbs, farmer, of that place. **Swindon Advertiser and North Wilts Chronicle, 21 March 1859**

**1860**
