Burials 1790 Smallpox Epidemic "The small pox raged so furiously that the whole parish were necessitated to be inoculated." **Edward Clarke**

"In the year 1809, a new Vicarage house began to be erected on the premises at Highworth which was completed in the Autumn of 1810. For this purpose, the profits of this Vicarage were mortgaged for a sum of 850£ to be paid off by instalments in 20 years according to the Act of Parliament in that behalf." **Edw Rowden**

1811 Population Figures "The above account of the population of the parish was taken by **Thomas Godwin** who at the time, held the office of Additional Overseer." **Edw Rowden**
