Sudden Death of a Child

An inquest has been held at the Lion and Fiddle Inn, before Mr. George Sylvester, coroner, on the body of Isabella Pike, 4 years old, daughter of Mr. Joseph Pike, farmer. From the medical evidence it appeared that the child died from congestion of the brain, and a verdict of "Died by the visitation of God" was returned.
