

Funeral of Mr Fred White

The funeral of Mr Fred White of "The Beeches", for over 30 years the parish representative on the Rural District Council, and whose death was reported in our last issue, took place on Saturday.

Born at Hindon, Mr White had lived and farmed in the parish the whole of his life and had always been ready and willing to assist in anything which was for the benefit of the neighbourhood.

The funeral service, which was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev L. Wilkinson) was held in the Parish Church at Chicklade, interment being in a grave alongside that of his wife, who predeceased him in 1933.
