Marriage of Jacob Jones and Mary Pegler is recorded in the March Quarter of 1852 in the Chippenham Registration District

This is possibly Mary Pegler in the 1851 census:

The 1851 census shows Ann Pegler, 18, unmarried, who was born at Bremhill, living with her parents at Kington St Michael. The parents were Benjamin Pegler a butcher and yeoman, with 200 acres, employing 8 labourers, and his wife Lydea, and younger brothers and sisters, Thomas, 16, Isaac, 14, Christopher, 13, George, 11, Louisa, 8, Benjamin, 3 and William, an infant.

It is believed that Mary/Ann is in fact Mary Ann Pegler
