

Swindon & District Directory Extract 1928 Little Bedwyn



Little Bedwyn, which includes the hamlet of Chisbury, is situated 1½ miles from Great Bedwyn Station, G.W.R. and 4 from Hungerford, and is in the Devizes Division of Wilts, Union and County Court District of Hungerford, Petty Sessional Division of Marlborough and Ramsbury, and Diocese of Salisbury. The register of the Church of St. Michael dates from 1722, and the living, which is a vicarage, net yearly value £130, and residence, is the gift of the Marquis of Ailesbury. There is a School (mixed), built in 1854, with residence for master, to hold 120. The Marquis of Ailesbury (who is Lord of the Manor) and Mr. E. B. Gauntlett are the chief landowners. The area is 4.343 acres; rateable value, £3.791; the population of Little Bedwyn and Chisbury in 1921 was 437. Letters arrive from Hungerford and are despatched on week days at 11.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. The nearest Money Order and Telegraph Office is at Great Bedwyn.

BURWOOD HEATH is 1 mile south-east
CHISBURY (the site of an ancient camp) is 1 mile west
and TIMBRIDGE is 4 miles west.
