1827

William Elkins, of Alderbury, and Richard Embling, of Liddiard Tregoze, for three months each, for breaches of the Game Laws. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 12 November 1827

1833

William Odey, of Liddiard Tregoze, charged with having maliciously discharged a loaded gun, on the night of the 29th October at the window of the dwelling house of Robert Hiscock, at the above place.
