

Malmesbury - Parish Relief Order for Militia Sickness of Benjamin Morgan 1780

Malmesbury, County of Wilts.

To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the poor of the parish of Malmesbury in the said Borough.

Whereas Benjamin Morgan, private Soldier in the Wiltshire Regiment of Militia, in Captain St. John's Company, is disabled by sicknefs to march – There are therefore to require you the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the poor of the said parish or some one of you, to relieve the said Benjamin Morgan with the Sum of Two Shillings and eleven pence per week, which said sum appears to me to be reasonable for the support and maintenance of the said Benjamin Morgan, till he shall be able to march or till this Warrant shall be countermanded.

Given under my Hand and Seal the 2nd day of November 1780.
