## PIG STEALING TWO GUINEAS REWARD

Whereas sometime in the Night of Thursday the 14<sup>th</sup> instant, - TWO SPOTTED SOW PIGS , both in farrow, the property of Mr. Chas. Alexander, were feloniously STOLEN and carried away from his Farm at Manningford Bohune in the County of Wilts.

Whoever will give such information as shall lead to the conviction of the offender shall receive the above Reward, upon application to Mr. Ings, Solicitor, Devizes. – If two or more were concerned, and either of them will impeach his accomplice or accomplices, he shall receive the above Reward, and application will be made to obtain a free pardon. *Devizes, August 21 1823*.

**Committed to the House of Correction, Devizes.** John Batchelor for 3 months, for non-performance of an order for bastardy, due to the parish of Manningford Bohun.

Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette - Thursday, 20 October 1825

**Commited to Fisherton Gaol**: - George Osland for stealing two pigs at Manningford Bohune.
