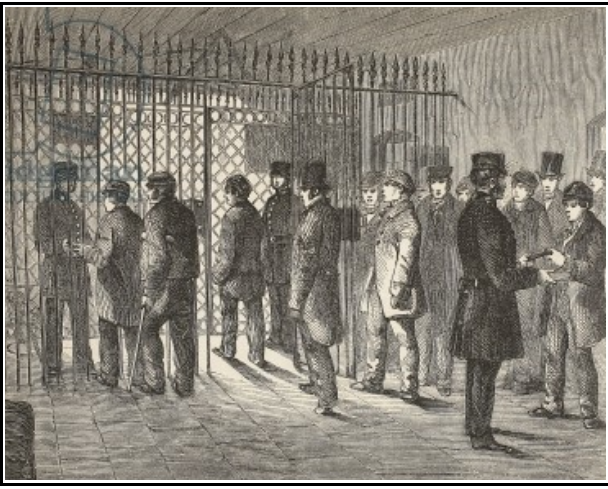


Crime and Punishment

Leaving Service

Joseph Sainsbury, a labourer, hired by the year, in the employ of Mr. William Sainsbury, of Market Lavington, was summoned for leaving his master's service. He worked until some two months ago, when he gave the bailiff notice that he intended to leave in a fortnight, and at the expiration of that time he went off. The contract having been proved by Mr. Sainsbury's bailiff, and the amount of loss by that gentleman himself, the defendant was fined 10s, and 10s costs, or, in default, 14 days' imprisonment.
