

Serious Accident

On Monday last, as the Hon. Mrs. Hay, of Clyffe Hall, Lavington, was returning home from Devizes, she met with a serious accident. On leaving the Rectory, where she had been calling on Mr. and Mrs. Wood, the horses started off at great speed, which so increased as to alarm Mrs. Hall, who dreading what might happen in the descent of the hill leading to Potterne, jumped out of the carriage, near the turnpike gate, and, falling on her head, was so injured as to be insensible for some time. She was brought back to the Rectory, where medical attendance was immediately procured, and was enabled to leave for home, in a fly, in the course of a few hours. We are happy to hear that she is progressing very favourably. The horses were stopped in ascending the next hill.
