DEVIZES UNION

PERSONS desirous of CONTRACTING with the Guardians of this Union to furnish such BREAD and FLOUR as may be ordered by the Relieving Officer from the 24th day of June instant to the 29th day of September following, for the respective districts of the Union comprising the following parishes and places, viz.

The Devizes District

Comprising Saint John's, Devizes; Saint Mary, Devizes; and the Chapelry of St James.

The Bromham and Potterne District

Comprising Bromham, Chittoe, Marston, Poulshot, Potterne, Rowde, and Worton.

The Bishops Cannings District

Comprising Allcannings, Allington, Alton Barnes, Beechingstoke, Bishops Cannings, Chirton, Etchilhampton, Marden, Patney, Stanton Saint Bernard, and Stert.

The Lavington District

Comprising Little Cheverell, Great Cheverell, Erlestoke, Easterton, Market Lavington, Urchfont, and West Lavington

Are requested to deliver sealed Tenders at the Board of Guardians in Devizes on or before 10 o'clock in the forenoon, on TUESDAY the 19th of June instant.

The Bread and Flour to be of the best seconds, and to be delivered in each parish of the Union, in such quantities, and at such times and places, as the Relieving Officers shall direct. The Bread to be delivered (the day after it is baked) in loaves of 2, 4, and 8lbs each, avoirdupois weight, of 16 ounces to the pound, according to the statute.

The Contractor will be required to give security (at the expense of the Board) for the due performance of the contract.
