Inquest Report on Eliza Doddington

Child Died of Burns

Inquest held by George Sylvester, esquire on November 16th at Mere, on the body of Eliza Doddington: A child, two and a half years of age, who being left in the house by her mother, ran out of the door into the street enveloped in flames, the effects of which destroyed her life in seventeen hours.

Verdict: "Accidental Death."
