#### 1888

At sea, May 22nd, on board H.M.S. Thalia, William Henry Ludlow Gale, Lieutenant R.N., aged 33, eldest son of John Henry and Augusta Gale, of Milton, near Pewsey. Buried at sea on May 23rd. Marlborough Times, 30 June 1888

# 1893

On the 30th January at Milton Vicarage, Pewsey, The Rev. John Henry Gale, for 47 years Vicar of the parish, aged 72. No flowers, by special request. Marlborough Times, 4 February 1893
