LABOURER DIES FROM HIS INJURIES

A labourer named William Head (54) of New Mill, Milton Lilbourne, has died in Savernake Hospital as the result of an accident which occurred on Wednesday night.

About 11pm, Head was leading two horses from the direction of Pewsey when, by some means, a bus belonging to Mssrs. Lampard of Pewsey collided with the animals and the man in charge.

At the time he was only 20 yards away from the yard into which he intended to turn. Head was terribly injured and was at once rushed to the hospital.

The bus, which was driven by R. Lovelock of Burbage, was empty at the time of the accident.

Head was employed by Mr. Alfred Munday, a farmer, of Milton Lilbourne. An inquest will be held today.
