Private Archibald Ware

Private A. Ware, Service No: 10832; Date of Death: 11th March 1915, aged 21. "D" Coy, 2nd Bn. Wiltshire Regiment.

Commemorated at Le Touret Memorial on Panel 33 and 34. Son of William Uriah and Maud Ware of 127 Earlscourt Road., Amesbury, Salisbury.

Archibald Ware was born in the Blandford Dorset Registration District in the September Quarter of 1893.

The 1901 census at Whatcombe, Winterborne Whitchurch, Dorset records:- Parents, William, 40, Farm Dairyman, Maude, 37, Archibald, 7, and his brothers and sisters, Albert C., 16, Winifred, 12, Ethel, 11,

Sidney W. 9, Harold P. 4, Norris F., 3, Mabel K., 1, and Ernest G. an infant. The children and their father all born at Whatcombe, Whitchurch, Dorset.

In the 1911 census, Archibald Ware, son, 18 is recorded at Bishops Caundle, Dorset
