as conveniently can after my decease sell and dispose of the stock standing in my name in the books of the Governor and Company of the Bank of England and shall and do in the first place pay and discharge All my just debts ffuneral expences and the Costs and Charges of proving this my Will and after payment and satisfaction of the same that she the said Celia Rose shall and do divide the whole of my said Estate and Effects into four equal shares or portions And I do hereby give and bequeath the same unto my Brothers Richard Strugnall and Joseph Strugnal my Sister Ann Willis and my Niece Mary Willis to and for the use of them my said Brothers Sister and Niece absolutely for ever And I do hereby constitute nominate and appoint the said Celia Rose sole Executrix of this last Will and Testament In Witness whereof and revoking all former Wills I have to this my said last Will & Testament set my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of October in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixteen Sarah Strugnad
