<b>State of Bodily Health, Strength and Probable Usefulness</b>	Very Good
<b>Arrival Date</b>	9 <sup>th</sup> November 1840
<b>Vessel</b>	Royal Consort
<b>Relatives in the Colony</b>	None
<b>Remarks</b>	Joseph travelled out with his wife Jane (a Cook from County Wicklow). Joseph was brought out by John Marshall.
